Sun-Safety Guidance



Please remember to apply sun cream to your children before their session and provide them with a labelled sun hat. Remember that the sun can come out later even on a cloudy day!



If your child arrives without sun cream we will ask you to apply it before you leave.

We will only reapply sun-cream if your child is attending all day. Please give your named

bottle of sun cream to your child's keyperson. **DO NOT** leave any sun cream in your child's bag.



Please make sure that your child wears adequate footwear suitable for climbing, pedalling etc - no flip-flops, crocs or flimsy footwear. Please ensure shoulders are covered. Thank you.


